Baptism promises made by parents and godparents

Ideas to support faith at home

Explore some of the Bible stories together from *The Barnabas Family Bible* (Baptism gift from Holy Trinity Church)

Come along to monthly Teatime Church Services and/or our special all-age 10am Sunday services

Come along to our weekly toddler group, *Toddlers Together*Attend local 'Messy Church' events
Attend church social events

Say grace together before eating dinner – use some ideas here! Say a prayer together before bed – use some ideas here! Explore and say the Lord's Prayer together

Discuss the questions posed at the end of the Teatime Church monthly newsletter together or come up with your own questions to ask Sing Christian songs together – use some ideas here!

Go on a prayer walk, searching for things that you are all thankful for Take it in turns to say...thank you God for.....and keep it going as long

Encourage your child to keep a prayer journal – a book where they can write their own prayers/have a conversation with God

Buy gifts, such as Christian crafts, that support a growing faith – there are lots available online

Simple prayer and song ideas to use at home

- Try a five-finger prayer: children can move a finger around their hand and say a prayer on each finger, or they can draw around their hand and write a prayer on each finger.
- Rainbow prayer children can draw a rainbow and use each colour to pray about something.
- A B C D E F G. Thank you for this food for me! Amen!
- Dear Lord, bless this bunch, as we munch on our lunch.
- God I know you love me and by my side you'll stay. Thanks for watching over me in your very special way. God I know you see me, you're with me as I pray. Thanks for watching over me, til' night time turns to day.
- Sing 'rock a bye baby' replacing the last line with: the cradle won't fall cause god's holding baby, cradle and all!
